## Scaling Climate Action through Local Leadership

### The Building Performance Partnership (BPP) Network

The BPP Network was created by Building Energy Exchange (BE-Ex) and the Institute for Market Transformation (IMT) to accelerate and scale building performance solutions. As of 2026, the BPP Network membership includes local Partner Hubs in nine locations that collectively reach over 7.6 billion square feet of commercial and residential real estate.

### What is a Hub?

A hub is a local nonprofit organization that provides resources to advance energy efficiency in buildings, such as training, financing solutions, and educational tools that cater to the needs of its community. Often these efforts are aligned to help successfully implement local building efficiency policies, such as energy benchmarking or building performance standards.

Through the BPP Network, hubs receive guidance, expertise, peer sharing, access to a variety of educational resources, and connection to business opportunities to advance their work.

### How to Get Involved:

A BPP Network sponsorship of \$5,000 per year provides:

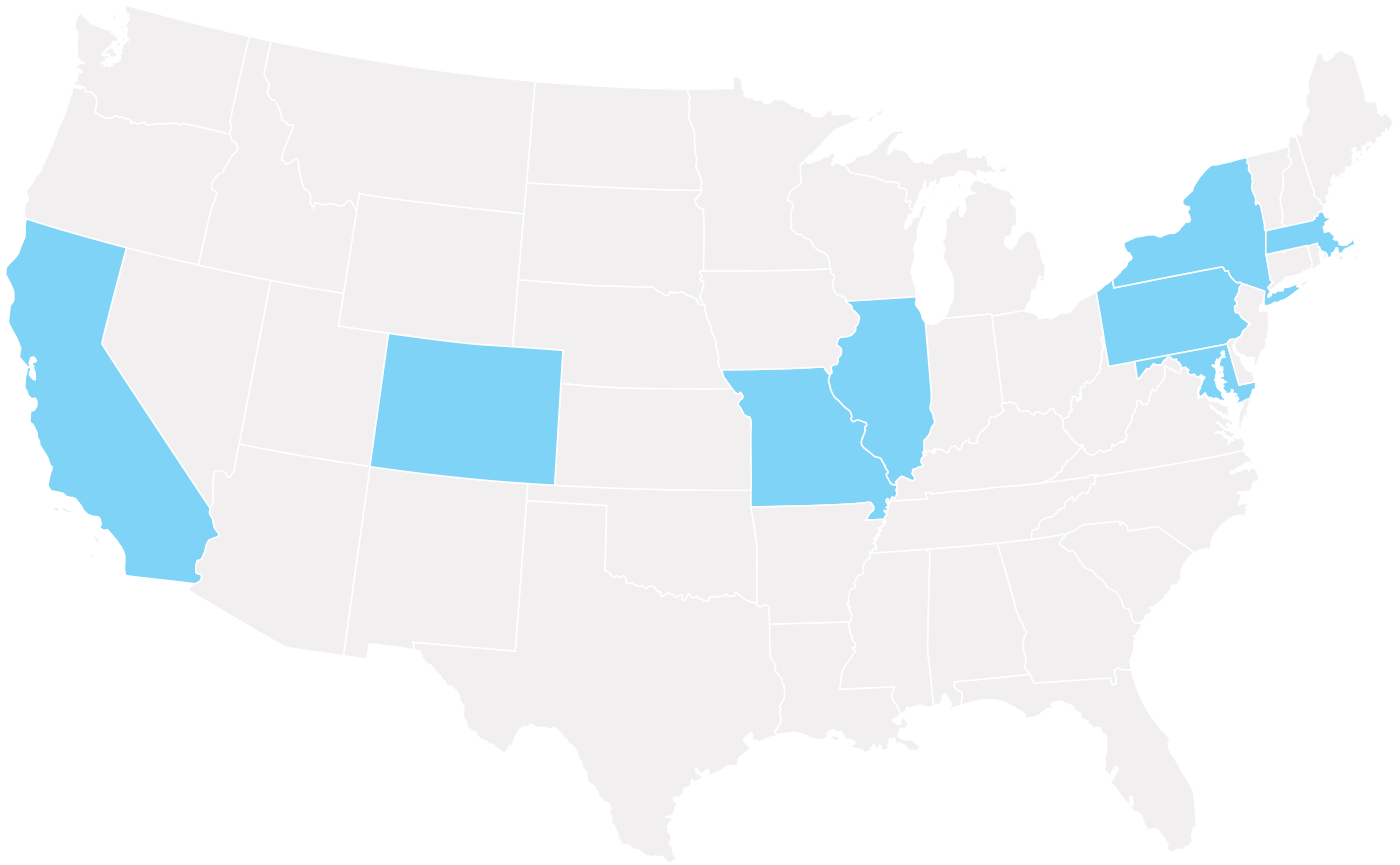
- Marketing exposure through your logo on the BPP Network website and on any BPP supported webinars/ events
